The Navy's post-World War II public affairs program was built on a nucleus of 40 Naval Reserve officers appointed as public information specialists in the Regular Navy shortly after the war. The program also included hundreds of Naval Reserve officers and enlisted personnel who had served in public information billets during the war, most of whom had returned to inactive duty by 1950. Since those early years, this body of regular and reserve officers, journalists, photographers, photo-journalists and civilians has expanded into a substantial community of professionals telling the Navy's story.

The U.S. Navy Public Affairs Alumni Association was established in 1994 to honor and celebrate this rich heritage and

to keep alive the friendships we have made during an important part of our lives. USNPAAA enables its members to stay in touch and occasionally to get together. The Association holds reunions about every 18 months and publishes a quarterly newsletter and an annual membership directory. *Many of our members are still on active duty; you don't have to be retired to join.*

The USNPAAA Board of Directors voted to reduce its regular one-time payment for Life Membership to \$50 for Active Duty Officer and Enlisted, USN or USNR, Drilling USNR, and Navy Civilian Public Affairs Specialists.

*No other dues are assessed from Life members.*
